This is an incredibly difficult and challenging time for all us and we are all having to adapt to new ways of living and working. However we want you all to know that we're still here to help and serve as best as we can, whilst also adhering to the advice coming from the government.

Here is what we're currently doing at Storehouse to continue serving the most vulnerable people in our city.

PROVISION

FOOD

We are continuing to provide emergency food provision to those that are in need, but we have had to restrict access to the Storehouse Centre for the foreseeable future.

If you work for one of our referring partners and you identify a client in need of food provision, please encourage them to visit the Storehouse Centre during our opening times detailed below, and we will provide them with a food parcel at the door.

MON 1000 - 1230

WED 1300 - 1530

We still require them to have a referral letter from yourselves, but we understand that you may have difficulty giving it to them at present. In this instance, please email it to info@storehousebelfast.com before they are due to visit.

If your client isn't able to visit the Storehouse Centre because they are needing to self-isolate, you can collect a food parcel on their behalf.

Under certain circumstances, we may be able to deliver a food parcel to your client directly. We need to prioritise this service to those that are self-isolating and cannot visit the Storehouse Centre themselves, or don't have anyone that could collect on their behalf, so please only request this if absolutely necessary.

We have re-opened our clothing boutique on an appointment only basis. Appointments will be on Tuesday evenings or Thursday mornings and will last for 20 minutes per person/household.
